OVERVIEW | Bodegas Monasterio de Corias is a tiny producer working exclusively with the native grapes found in the mountainside region of Cangas. Old vines planted in pure slate yield wines pack with minerals. They make 3 cuvees, all them are field blends of Carrasquin, Verdejo Negro & Mencia. The wines are fermented with wild yeast and bottle without filtration. The three bottlings account for just 800 cases each year.

VINEYARD/CELLAR PRACTICES | From the cellar of the Monastery of Corias quality care of the grapes that go into it is considered essential. Pesticides are avoided and vineyard recovery is underway with new plantings replacing old ones within the grounds of the monastery for which the winery is named. The wines are all produced in the modernized cellar at bodega benedictina del Monasterio de San Juan Bautista de Corias. Updated in 2001, the perfect natural conditions of the site are supplemented with modern equipment that allows a pampered and careful winemaking that depart from it.

WINES | **Monasterio de Corias Monasterio** - The grains of the Mencia, verdejo negro, Carrasquin, & albarin negro and have remained a long maceration on the skins, then raised in oak barrels, bottling before resting a few months to round them out. The wine's intense aromas are reminiscent of the traditional high altitude wine growing country.
