OVERVIEW | Franco Noussan's small winery started in 2004, though Franco had been tending the vineyards of his wife, Gabriella's, family for five years before that. This is when he started the recovery of old vineyards by planting of petit rouge, mayolet, fumin, and pinot gris.

VINEYARD AREA: 0.55 hectares

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: 1500 cases

SOIL TYPES: sand, clay, gravel

GRAPE VARIETIES: petit rouge, cornalin, vien de Nus, gamay, pinot noir, others

Initially the production was intended for family consumption, then in 2003 the decision was made to purchase vineyards in order to have an area of 5500 meters, and to found a company regulated by the production and marketing of wine.

VINEYARD/CELLAR PRACTICES | The work in the vineyard is entirely manual and is performed with great passion and respect for nature, using natural fertilizers and in fact, joining the EEC Regulation 20/78 agri-environmental measures, using only pesticides allowed.

The wine made with traditional techniques using the natural cold means that the product is not subject to clarification, seeking to give a product as natural as possible and reflecting the typical characteristics of the wines of this beautiful valley.
