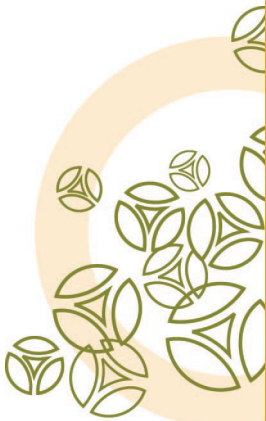
OVERVIEW | Johann Poller started producing wines in the early 1920s. Today, with 15 ha of vineyards, Pollerhof has a distinguished history of producing wines in Rösschitz, a village situated in the western part of the Weinviertel region near the old village Retz, not far from the Czech border. Erwin Poller and his family have managed the estate since 1992, after working in Germany, Italy, France and the USA.



VINEYARD/CELLAR PRACTICES | Beginning in 2005 Pollerhof began to work organically. White wine is the main thing here: Grüner Veltliner, Gelber Muskateller, Malvasia (here known as Frühroter Veltliner), Riesling, Gewürztraminer, Welschriesling, Rivaner, and Sauvignon Blanc round out an impressive collection. In red, there is Zweigelt, Blauburger, along with small quantities of Gamay, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Blauer Portugieser.

All vineyards are worked by hand. Only ripe, clean grapes are used for winemaking. Small boxes are used for the gentle transport of the grapes from the vineyard to the cellar. The grapes are pressed with one of the most gentle presses on the market. Stalks are damaged as little as possible and so no bitterness is released into the must.

WINES | **Grüner Veltliner (1L)** - A fresh and zesty wine not to fuss over. It has a lovely nose of grapefruit and snap pea, with hints of white pepper, spring flowers and wet stones.

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
