OVERVIEW | At the foot of the Montagne de Reims in Gueux lie the vineyards of Jérôme Prevost, who learned his trade working for the great Anselme Selosse. Like the wines of Selosse, these show a rounder, oak influenced, more vinuous quality than typical Champagnes. The vinuousness and lack of dosage help these wines to work exceptionally well as food wines. Though new on the scene Prevost already has cult status.

VINEYARD AREA: 2.2 hectares

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: 500 cases

SOIL TYPES: fossil rich sand

VARIETALS: pinot meunier

VINEYARD/CELLAR PRACTICES | Organic, 45 year old vines. Still wines for “Les Béguines” spend 6 months in 1-10 year old barrels before being bottled for the *prise de mousse*.
