**overview** | Sattlerhof Winery is one of the leading and internationally most renowned wine estates in Southern Styria. The family business cultivates 30 hectares of vineyards, with Sauvignon Blanc as the most common variety. With the Hotel and Restaurant Sattlerhof, run by Hannes Sattler, the winery is among Styria's top destinations for connoisseurs of fine food and wine.

**vineyard area:** 30 hectares

**top sites:** Kranachberg, Sernauberg, Pfarrweingarten

**soil types:** Chalk, sand, mica slate

**grape varieties:** sauvignon blanc, morillon, weißburgunder, gelber muskateller

Sattlerhof is situated south of Gamlitz on a steep hill with fabulous views of the Southern Styrian landscape. This village is called Sernau, and Sattlerhof is house number 2, which would suggest that this is a centuries-old address. Documents show that the farm has been in the family since 1887. Today Sattlerhof is devoted totally to the culture of pleasure, with wine playing a central role in this regard.

Willi Sattler has been responsible for the cultivation of wine here since he was 22 years old. Thanks to his skill, Sattlerhof wines have over the decades earned the respect of innumerable wine-lovers and the international wine media.

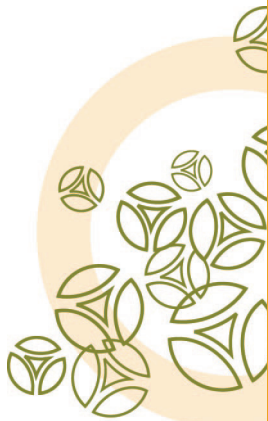
The combination of tradition and innovation plays a uniquely important role in quality at Sattlerhof. Tradition means a natural and intensive management of the vineyards, while incorporating the vintner's vast knowledge of the idiosyncrasies of the terroir and the vines, which comes only from decades of close involvement with his wine-growing estate.

Innovation means constantly developing new wine-processing methods, investing in cellar technology and consistently implementing ideas that bring out the varietal character even better and accentuate those qualities of the wine that are typical of the region.

**the vineyards** | The Kranachberg site extends from Gamlitz to Leutschach and is planted primarily to Sauvignon Blanc (about 90 %). The unique composition of this soil (chalky sand with white mica) lends the wines a distinctive spicy note with unmistakable fruit.

The Sernauberg site is a southeast-facing basin with extremely steep slopes and fine, sandy soil with a gravelly covering. Primarily Sauvignon Blanc and Morillon varieties are grown here.

The Pfarrweingarten is a small, well protected, south-facing basin-shaped site cultivated exclusively by Sattlerhof. The soil, containing shell and coralline limestone, offers ideal conditions for Burgundy varieties.
